## ABOUT LEGACY

Legacy got his beginnings in the art of turntablism while attending college in Baltimore and playing on the local college campuses. He went on to hold down local clubs like Club Choices, 409 Gallery, Liquid, and Spike & Charlie's among others. Word spread and he found himself traveling from Delaware, to Philly, and back to Miami to perform for entities like SOBE, Spirits, and so on.

In 2002, Legacy's crew, the 5 Star Generals, began making a name for themselves on staple Atlanta radio stations and the club circuit. Soon Legacy was being recognized for his individual abilities on the turntables that began earning him national attention. Since the spring of 2005, DJ Legacy has been the National Tour DJ for MTV/mtvU and was featured on MTV's "Making the Band Season Finale 3 & 4", "Rock Paper Scissors", and "Wild'N'Out" and continues to rock yearly MTV special events and tours such as Spring Break, VMA Tour, and Campus Invasion.

DJ Legacy's influences have been greats such as Funk Master Flex (NYC), Super Funk Regulator DJ Ceelo (DC), and Stone Love (JA). His mixtape albums include Heatwave Vol. 1 & 2, FullSpeed Live and Direct, and Spring F'N Break Vol. 1. Legacy has also been a fixture on the Hollywood scene on major movie promotions with both Paramount Pictures and Warner Brothers Entertainment on projects like Star Trek and Iron Man. He has performed more than 2,200 shows for World Renowned Brands and Artists such as Diddy, Katy Perry, Coke, Dove, etc..., throughout the United States, Europe, Mexico, and the Caribbean.
